Art Quilts

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Modd Muggs (or Quilted Portraits)

Supplies needed:

Sewing machine with satin stitch (bring, but leave in your car as we may not need)

Rotary cutter

Cutting matt

Ruler

Scissors (cloth and paper scissors, plus a small pointed scissors for small pieces)

Pins

Needles

Buttons for eyes

Thread—various colors (Thread is part of your color palette)

Pencils, Pens, eraser

Nine (or 16) sheets of 8 ½ x 11 paper for printing quilt pattern

Pressing cloth (at least 10"x20")

(We'll each be making 9 (or 16) photo copies—hopefully there will be a copier or printer available! ☺)

Please have all of your squares cut before the class:

9 (or 16) eight inch squares of different fabrics—contrasting colors and patterns

(It works if you buy ¼ yard of each)

9 (or 16) eight inch squares of "Wonder Under", (buy 1.25 yd)

9 (or 16) eight inch squares of "Stitch n'Tear", (buy 1.25 yd)

9 (or 16) eight inch squares of a solid color fabric for the appliqué foundation

Please bring five or six extra 8 inch squares for the color choosing process and to share and trade with others. This increases the possibilities of choice!

The goal of this one day workshop is to make nine eight inch square blocks, each with a fun fabric face. These can be used in any arrangement you choose for a delightful quilt for your wall or bed.
