

## Supply List Ten Easy Pieces

Sewing machine with satin stitch
Scissors with a nice sharp point for cutting small shapes
Pins, Needles
Thread-various colors (Thread is part of your color palette)
Pencil and eraser
$81 / 2 \times 11$ paper for copying quilt patterns (about 20 sheets)
(We'll be making ten photo copies(:)
Please bring a variety of sizes, shapes and colors of buttons
Kits for covered buttons
Small embellishments of your choice
Three fabrics to cut into strips for braids
Various fabrics for borders and backing
Wonder Under for fusing fabric embellishments
Pressing cloth
Rotary Cutter
Cutting matt
Ruler

## Please have all of your squares cut before the class:

Ten 8 inch squares of different fabrics-contrasting colors and patterns
Ten 8 inch squares of "Wonder Under" (please by the light weight kind—not heavy duty)
Ten 8 inch squares of "Stitch n'Tear" (stabilizer-a Pellon product OR you can use computer paper which works just as well)
Ten 8 inch squares of black fabric for the appliqué foundation

PS--Please bring five or six extra 8 inch squares for the color choosing process and to share and trade with others. This increases the possibilities of choices!
