Room Set-up

Irons to share Ironing boards to share Rotary cutter to share Cutting matt to share Ruler to share Students to bring 8 ½ x 11 paper for copying quilt pattern (about 20 sheets for each student) Printer or copier to make sixteen photo copies of patterns per student ©

We will need some form of copier for the Quilted Portraits Class for copying everyone's pattern four times. During one of my classes, the guild provided an Epson RX680 3 in one printer. We scanned the patterns and printed out copies of them. This worked very well. Other times, we found a copy store nearby and made a trip to copy everyone's pattern. Or, perhaps, the place where the workshop is being held might have an office with a copier available. At any rate, it might be a good idea to have plenty of printer paper on hand.
